

Cancellation, Withdrawal and Refund policy

1. Cancellation

- a. You have the right to cancel your course of instruction, without any penalty or obligation, through attendance at the first class session (or as defined below) or seven days after enrollment, whichever comes later (the "**Cancellation Period**").
- b. Cancellation is effective when the student provides a written notice of cancellation to the Company. This can be done by email or by hand delivery.
- c. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- d. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- e. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled the Company will refund the student any money he/ she paid, less an application fee specified below in the Tuition chart within 30 days after the notice of cancellation is received.

2. Withdrawal

- a. You may withdraw from any course at any time after the Cancellation Period (described above) and refunds are determined in accordance with the Refund Policy stated below.
- b. For the purpose of determining a refund under this section, a student shall be deemed to have withdrawn from a course of instruction when any of the following occurs:
 - i. The student notifies the Company in writing of the student's withdrawal. The notification is effective when the Company receives the notice.
 - ii. The failure of a student to immediately notify the school in writing of the student's intent to withdraw may delay a refund of tuition to the student.
 - iii. The Company terminates the student's enrollment for failure to maintain satisfactory progress; failure to abide by the rules of the class; absences in excess of maximum set forth by the Company; and/or failure to meet financial obligations to the Company.
 - iv. The student has failed to attend class for 4 class meetings without prior approval.
- c. The official termination date of enrollment shall be the student's last day in class.
- d. Students who withdraw due to an emergency, such as personal or family illness or national service, may be re-enrolled into another course following approval by the Company.

3. Refund

- a. Refund of tuition for the Bootcamps will be in accordance with the following guidelines:

Duration	Refund
During the cancellation period (attendance at the first class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later)	100% of tuition
During the 1st quarter of the course	75% of tuition
During the 2nd quarter of the course	50% of tuition
During the 3rd quarter of the course	25% of tuition
During the 4th quarter of the course	no refund



- b. For the purposes of determining the date of withdrawal, the date shall be the earliest of:
- i. the date on which the student gives written notice to the Company or
 - ii. the date on which the student is deemed to have withdrawn.
- c. Refund of tuition for part-time courses will be in accordance with the following guidelines:
 During the 1st half of the course - 25% of tuition
 During the 2nd half of the course - no refund
